

PASTOR'S HEART | A Generous Life

When you think about godly generosity, what person or circumstance comes to mind?

Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. How does Paul tell Timothy to instruct those who are rich?

What does it mean to be “rich in this present world?” What does it mean to be “rich in good deeds” and to be “generous and willing to share?”

Why is it a danger for rich Christians to become arrogant and put their hope in wealth?

Who does verse 17 say is the ultimate provider of wealth? How should this affect a person’s view of such things? What benefits are given for Christians who live by these commands?

How have you seen these lessons played out in your life? What other observations can you make from these verses?

What additional insights on Christian generosity can be found in **2 Corinthians 8:1-4, 9:6-7, 9:10-12?**

Application Questions:

What has challenged you the most from the passages in this lesson?

How might you live differently as a result of what you have learned today?
