HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: Full Assurance

When was the last time you felt really nervous? Where were you? What were you about to do? What do you do when you feel nervous about something?

Read [Hebrews 10:19-25](#).

Look back at the verses leading up to this passage to remember the context. Notice the logical flow of ideas indicated with words like “therefore,” “since,” etc.

Underline the phrases that begin with “let us.” What does each of these phrases encourage us to do?

What does this passage tell you about the character of God? What does it teach you about what Christ accomplished on the cross for you?

Do you feel confident in approaching God? What are you believing or doing that keeps you from feeling the full confidence of Christ’s redeeming sacrifice?

How can you encourage others toward love and good deeds today? Plan to do what God has prompted you to do.

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week?

Close your time together in prayer, thanking God for inviting you into His presence and listening to you even now. Ask Him to help you draw near to Him, trust in Him, and live a life that encourages others to love and live for Jesus.
