HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: Jesus Destroyed Death and the Devil | [Hebrews 2:10-18](#)

A Study of Hebrews is a devotional book produced by Fellowship to aid in understanding the book of Hebrews. The questions in the weekly discussion guide can be found in this book, along with daily readings, devotionals, and other inspirational material.

Do you like sweet treats or salty snacks? Are you tempted more by the last slice of pie or the cold soda in the bottom of the ice chest? What is the food that always tempts you when you are trying to eat right?

Read [Hebrews 2:10-18](#).

Throughout the Hebrews series you will be encouraged to write in your Bible. If you aren't comfortable writing in your Bible, consider printing out the text and marking it, or purchasing a Hebrews journal Bible you can write in.

Circle the repeated words in the text. Why are these words repeated?

Underline the phrases that show what Jesus is compared to. What does this tell you about Jesus? Which of these comparisons is most meaningful to you?

How does Jesus' experience as a human affect the way you relate to Him?

In what area are you currently facing temptation? How can you invite Jesus into that temptation so He can help you flee from it today?

How have you suffered in the past year? How can you see Jesus offering healing and hope in the suffering?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week?

Close your time together in prayer. Thank Him that He is there for you in your temptation and suffering. Ask Him to place people in your life to walk alongside you and that He would give you the courage to confess to them what you are experiencing. Pray that you would see the ways Jesus is offering healing and hope in the suffering of this life.
