Besides coming to know the Lord, what would you say was another major “before and after” moment in your life? Maybe it was getting a good job, moving to a different place, or beginning a significant relationship. What was your life like before that big change, and how has it been since then?

GROW

Read [Ephesians 2:1-10](#) aloud.

How does Paul describe the before and after picture of a believer who comes to Christ? What are some key words in this passage that really strike you?

Do you recall what it felt like to be spiritually dead, thinking you were alive? What has changed since that time? Or if you have not yet accepted Christ’s invitation of grace and mercy, what is hindering you from receiving this gift?

According to verse 4, what motivated God’s gift of grace to us? In light of God’s free gift of grace, how do you express gratitude to God?

In [Ephesians 2:10](#) it says, “For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.” What do you think are those good works you are intended to do, and how are you living that out? As a group, how could you help each other discover and do the works you were created to do?

What does [verse 7](#) say awaits us “in the coming ages”? What is something you hope for in the future?

How has this study helped you to see Jesus more clearly?
