### Read [Hebrews 1:1-4](#).

Throughout the Hebrews series you will be encouraged to write in your Bible. If you aren't comfortable writing in your Bible, consider printing out the text and marking that, or purchasing a Hebrews journal Bible you can write in.

In your Bible, mark words that describe the Son or His work. How is Jesus described in this passage?

Circle the words "he became as much superior." The superiority of Jesus to everything which came before Him is one of the main themes of this letter to keep in mind as you read in the weeks ahead.

If the Creator God had not made Himself knowable and revealed Himself to us, we would not be able to know Him at all. How does it make you feel that the God of the Bible has chosen to make Himself knowable to humanity, and specifically to you?

What does the passage say about who Jesus is? What does that mean about who God is?

Look at the things you marked in the passage. Which stands out to you and why? How can you reflect on that attribute of Jesus throughout the day?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week? Close your time together in prayer.
