MISSION & VISION | Our City

Acts 19:23-27

Has the city where you lived changed much in the past 50 years? What about your hometown? What are some of the changes you have witnessed in your lifetime? What drives change in a community?

Read Acts 19:23-27. What is “the Way” that is mentioned in verse 23? Why is there controversy surrounding “the Way”?

What is at the heart of Demetrius’ objection to Paul’s message?

Read Acts 19:28-34. Imagine this scene! Why do you think the people reacted so strongly to the accusations that were being made? Why do you think Paul’s friends prohibited him from going to the scene of the riot?

Read Acts 19:35-42. Why do you think the town clerk was able to quell the crowd?

Do you think this riot had the effect Demetrius desired? Why or why not?

How is the Gospel impacting your city? How would you like to see the good news of Jesus impact your city? What could you and your group do to be part of a Gospel movement where you live?
