Read [Luke 24:13-27](#).

What were these two discussing as they walked along the road? How did the risen Jesus join into the conversation?

How does Cleopas describe Jesus of Nazareth for this stranger, and how would you describe the tone that he uses?

How has Jesus revealed Himself to you through His Word? How are you engaging with Jesus in this way currently?

To learn more about possible passages from the Old Testament that Jesus may have shared, look up and discuss [Isaiah 7:14](#), [Micah 5:2](#), [Zechariah 9:9](#), [Isaiah 53:4-12](#), [Zechariah 12:10](#), [Jeremiah 31:34](#), [Hosea 2:23](#), and [Daniel 7:14](#).

Read [Luke 24:28-35](#).

Why do you think Jesus took time to explain the Old Testament Scriptures rather than just reveal Himself to these two travelers? What do you think of as you read verse 32?

When was a time that Jesus revealed Himself to you when you may not have expected it? How can you relate to these two as they discover the truth of who He is?

If you were taking a walk with Jesus, what would you want to ask Him? What would you hope to talk about?

How is the joy that comes from knowing that Jesus has risen evident in your life? How are you declaring this to others?

How has this passage helped you see Jesus more clearly?
