Live as ONE

How can you relate with Israel's struggle for a good, godly king described in the devotional? Who or what rivals the leadership of Jesus in your life?

Live as SENT

What would it look like to surrender rival rulers and kingdoms to King Jesus and His Kingdom in your life? How would you be able to tell if that happened in your life? How would you be different?

What could it look like this week to live by the leadership of Jesus and participate in His Kingdom work in the world where you live, work, and play?
