The Book of the Revelation Introduction – 1:1-3 | Continued



Important to Remember


Symbolism is common in the Word of God.



Dear Lord Rothschild,

I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on behalf of His Majesty's Government, the following doclaration of sympathy with Jewish Zionist aspirations which has been submitted to, and approved by, the Cabinet

"His Majesty's Government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavours to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country"

I should be grateful if you would bring this declaration to the knowledge of the Zionist Federation.

The **Balfour Declaration** (dated 2 November 1917)

His Majesty's government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavours to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country.^[1]

Pre-Tribulation Events State of Israel (May 14, 1948)
