



IMAGE OF GOD

Image of God (Imago Dei) means "in likeness or similarity" to God. It's a metaphysical expression that includes human's moral, spiritual, and intellectual essence. Humans are created with unique abilities, absent in all other creatures of the earth, that mirror the divine nature of God. It reflects our connection with God.

Identity

*A social construct

- *One's psychological and social response to our environment.
- *The way a person feels It's just who we are...

Identity

When a person senses a dissonance between body and mind, the mind wins. The body is dismissed as irrelevant, inconsequential, and insignificant to who we are. All that matters is your inner feelings. Gender is a matter of feelings. Your body means nothing! (Powerful expression of individualism)

Identity

*What does some little bit of flesh between the legs matter?

Why should that make a difference to your **sense of** who you are?

How can anyone be forced to adopt an arbitrary gender that comes from a social construct especially if doing so detracts from their own happiness?

Identity

"My flat chest is not male, **it's** female."

"My beard is not male, **it's** female."

"My male genitals are female, **not** male."

Trans*

Umbrella term for the incongruence between gender identity (internal sense of who you are) and your biological sex.

-Highly flexible and complex

Psychological diagnosis for the distress some people experience when they live with the incongruence between gender identity and biological sex.

Incongruence

•Gender incongruence is "characterized by a marked and persistent incongruence between an individual's experienced gender and the assigned sex, which often leads to a desire to transition, in order to live and be accepted as a person of the experienced gender, through hormonal treatment, surgery, or other health care services to make the individual's body align, as much as desired and to the extent possible, with the experienced gender." (ICD-11)

Early onset - Distress begins in early childhood, (usu. age 2-4 years) Only a small number of these children will continue to have symptoms in later adolescence or adulthood.

Rapid onset gender dysphoria - An increasing social phenomenon;

Affects teens and adults who have identified with their own biological sex for years, then decide they want to change genders and sometimes alter their bodies.





The use of a word, especially a pronoun or form of address, that does not reflect their gender identity.

*Pronouns are linguistic tools that we use to refer to people. (i.e. he/him/his, she/her/hers, or binary pronouns)

De-Transition

(Desistance)

How often? We just don't know!

After some quiet reflection, Jim changed his mind about wanting a Hippopotamus for Christmas.



De-Transition – why?

(Littman, Lisa, Arch of Sex Behavior, 2021)

Discrimination (23.0%)

More comfortable identifying as their natal sex (60.0%)

Potential medical complications from transitioning (49.0%)

Discovered gender dysphoria was caused by trauma, abuse, or a mental health condition (38.0%)

Homophobia or difficulty accepting themselves as lesbian, gay, or bisexual (23.0%)

Majority (55.0%) felt that they did not receive an adequate evaluation from a doctor or mental health professional before starting transition

Only 24.0% of respondents informed their clinicians that they had detransitioned.

Intersex

Intersex is a general term used for a variety of conditions in which a person is born with a reproductive or sexual anatomy that doesn't seem to fit the typical definitions of female or male.

Intersex - Frequency

1 in 1500 to 1 in 2000 births. (Intersex Society of North America)

Klinefelter (XXY) one in 1,000 births
Androgen insensitivity syndrome one in 13,000 births
Partial androgen insensitivity syndrome one in 130,000 births
Classical congenital adrenal hyperplasia one in 13,000 births
Vaginal agenesis one in 6,000 births
Ovotestes one in 83,000 births

- 1. How is my soul?
- 2. Am I consistent in my love for people and my life?
- 3. Is this a new problem? No! We are swimming against culture. Think of Daniel, Judges, and Romans 1.
- 4. How do we *love* people who are trans*?

Our Response

How do we Engage?

- 5. Acknowledge we are absolute truth people living in a relative world.
- 6. Persuasion is best when subtle (through relationships)
- 7. Choose a truthful position with a graceful tone.
- 8. Make friends with a trans* person.
