When Life is Not Great

My heart sank as I read the news: a dear friend's grandchild was/is critically ill.

We walk through the days of our lives grateful for God's goodness, seeing evidence of His love and care all around us. And yet, our journeys take us to a time when life tumbles in. It was good for me to be reminded of the ways God is good even when life is not:



- 1. We can be assured that nothing happening on this earth is beyond His knowing and having the circumstance under His control. "I brought you from the ends of the earth; I called you from its farthest corners and said, 'You are My servant.' I did not reject you, but chose you. Do not be afraid I am with you!" (Good News Translation, Isaiah 41:9-10a)
- 2. When we are weak....it is His chance to pour His power into our inner beings that much more. "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:9) God's grace is sufficient for each one of His servants. We can know from His word and His promise that He will bestow His grace upon us and fill us up as we are in need.
- 3. When life tumbles in.....I am reminded that His thoughts and ways are not mine. I am reminded that He is working, even amidst my non-understanding. <u>Isaiah 55</u> reassures us that "....as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts." He teaches me to let go and let Him. He wants to see me leaning into Him, rather than leaning into my own reasoning. Fact is, God works in ways that are not revealed to me. And when I am puzzled, hurting and frustrated, believing these words is the best thing to do.
- 4. Now. We ask and pray for...now. And yet we wait. Is that God not answering my prayer? Is God hearing me? Does God see inside my mind and heart?... "He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end." (Ecclesiastes 3:11) In His truth, He explains,...no one can fathom. I must wait with Him. I must listen and hear what He says in silence.
- 5. Faithful: God is. I am, at times, and I am not, at times. But, with God....He is always faithful. It is a part of who God is. God never wavers. He is the constant even when our circumstances throw us into chaos. Visualize a mountain that cannot be moved. And stand on that.
- 6. Pain....to be turned into glory to Him? For us to turn to Him in our suffering, God moves in ways we can never imagine. When we cry out to Him, we are seeking Him and inviting Him into our pain. He allows the pain to be shared, He is carrying us even though we feel weak. But never alone. Never alone.
- 7. God=strong. Me=weak. "But he has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for

my power is perfected in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:9) We are weak anytime life does not go our way. We wrestle, grit our teeth, shout, cry out, proclaim aloud our human reasoning, become frustrated and angry. Then come the words: Child, surrender. Give it up. I can do the impossible. "The Lord will fight for you; you need only be still." (Exodus 14:14) It is in our silence, not trying to control our preferred outcomes, that God acts in profound ways.

Blue skies and rainbows?? Not a true picture of life here on earth. God knows the troubles of our earthly lives and of the evil we must live amongst. Many trials test the very fabric of our inmost beings. Yet.....God is still God. He is still Ruler. He is still good. And He still does good in my life.

- Start thinking of unique qualities God has given you instead of finding fault.
- Would others see you as contented or dissatisfied with your life circumstances?
- How grateful is your heart?





The Enneagram is a personality theory comprised of nine different types, or nine different ways of seeing the world. The goal is self-




Nehemiah: A Heart That Can Break


