Memory Verse

Genesis 12:1-3 or Abraham's Covenant (promise) in any story bible

- What is a promise? Are you a good or not so good promise keeper?
- Is God a good promise keeper?
- What does God promise to Abraham?
- Can you discuss places in the bible where we see these promises coming true?

1 John 4:9-10 NLT

God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. (K-2) This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. (3-5)
