

Genesis 6, 7—
Noah Builds a Boat

Floating Ark Puppet

Supplies

- copies of the floating ark puppet (1 per child)
- crayons or washable markers
- scissors
- glue
- craft sticks (1 per child)
- blue construction paper (½ sheet per child)

Directions

Help children color and cut out the ark puppet (cut around the solid outline, do not cut on the dotted line). Fold the ark on the dotted line so that the two sides are back to back. Glue the ark around the edges and glue a craft stick to the inside bottom of the ark (between the two halves), forming a two-sided stick puppet. Cut a long slit lengthwise in the center of the construction paper. Insert the ark puppet through the slit (see the example). Children can show the ark floating and tell about Noah building the ark, Noah, his family, and the animals getting into the ark, and the flood causing the ark to float.
