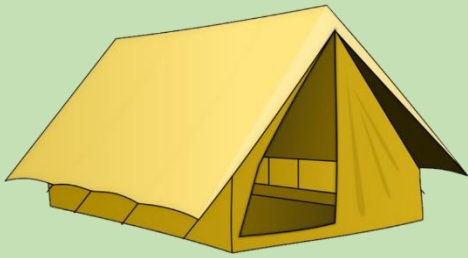

- Celebrate Isaac’s marriage to Rebekah and eat cake together!

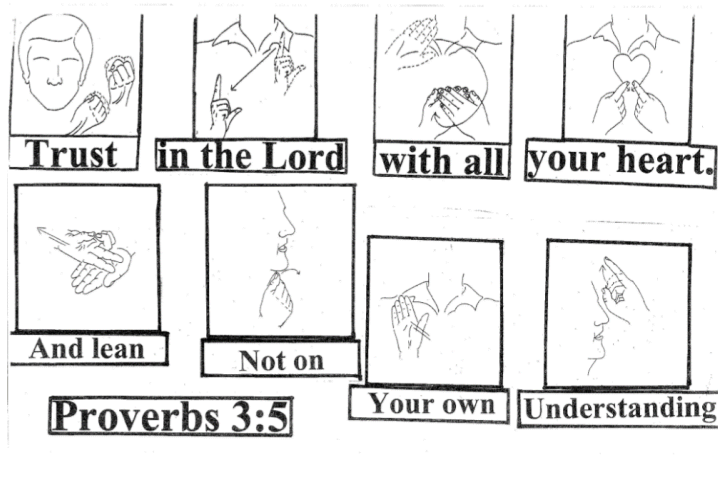
Bible Story

God's Promise to Abraham: The Read With Me Bible – Pages 40-44

Reference: Genesis 12:1 - 13:18
