A NEW CREATION | Freedom For A New Identity

Colossians 3:12-13

Go around the group and say words that identify who you are. (Parent, attorney, daughter, cancer survivor, etc.) How do these identities define you?

Read Colossians 3:1-11.

What are some things you have learned over the last two weeks? What are some things that Christ has given you freedom from?

This week, we are moving from discussing "freedom from" to discussing what we have "freedom for."

Read Colossians 3:12-13.

In what ways have you seen God make you a "new creation"? What has changed in your life since you became a follower of Christ?

What does it mean to you personally to be a child of God? How does this distinction change how you view yourself?

Would you say you have a "calling"? What is a ministry you are passionate about? What makes you pound the table? Are there areas of ministry where you feel upset when you see it is it's not being done or not being done well? If so, what are those areas? What are the obstacles that are standing in the way of you being used by God?

Review last week's prayer cards. Have you seen answered prayers? Pray for each other and renew your commitment to keep praying for the needs on the cards.
