Finding the Sweetness in the Grind

The hustle. The grind. The day-to-day of "getting it done." I hear these phrases come out of my mouth (and a lot of other women's mouths) often. Though it's a cultural catchphrase, we've almost idolized the idea of hustling with coffee in hand, and in the process, missed out on the sweetness of being purposeful within the hustle.

In the last few years of my life, there's been so much incredible life-change -- graduating college, landing my first job, getting married, moving and transitioning into my role here at Fellowship Fayetteville. Although I felt so much purpose in each of these monumental changes, those in-between seasons left me in a state of desiring what's next.

When we only live for the perfected and big moments of life, we miss out on how God is moving and working through us in the messy or even mundane moments of each day. Each of us has been crafted and designed to fully bloom in whatever state we find ourselves—not to lose hope for the future or become complacent, but to see the beauty of what God is doing in all moments—both in the grind and in the peace.

<u>Philippians 4:12-13</u> lays down some truth for those of us who struggle to see the purpose in these "in-between" moments in life stating, "I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. I can do all things through Him who strengthens me."

So the big question becomes, "How do we change this mentality we've adopted? How can I actually find joy and purpose in getting the groceries, sitting in the car line, answering yet another email and getting by on minimal sleep?

Reflect and Respond

• Seek the relationships that are right at your fingertips. <u>Galatians 6:2</u> says to "carry each other's burdens, in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ." Reach out to that mom sitting next to you in the car line and see how she is doing; that coworker you intentionally pass by because you know you don't have time -- take her out to lunch

- and listen to her. Slow down and allow God to give you purpose in those busy
- Allow yourself to be challenged by others. Proverbs 27:17 tells us that "As iron sharpens iron, one person sharpens another." Allow yourself to be challenged by others to live fully in each of the moments God is giving you. There is no moment so small that isn't worthy of praise. Find someone to keep you accountable to knowing and living out that truth.
- Go beyond getting through, and instead serve through. Samuel 12:24 reminds us, "But be sure to fear the Lord and serve him faithfully with all your heart; consider what great things he has done for you." Each day is an opportunity to be a beacon of God's light -- sometimes that light may be seen by many and other days only by a few -- but always by the Lord. Not giving God glory in all we do reveals a heart that doesn't see how God can use all we do for His glory and Kingdom.

When you find yourself in the grind, pause and allow God to fully use your mundane or messy moments to be a fragrant offering to Him (2 Corinthians 2:15) -- who knows, your fragrance may just stop somebody in their tracks and allow them to discover where your true purpose comes from.
