Where is the farthest you have ever been from home? What took you there? What about that place made you realize how different it was from home? Why do Christians not have to live in fear?

Would others describe you as someone

intentionally living out your faith in Jesus? What does that say about your walk with Jesus?

GROW

Read Acts 11:19-30.

Antioch was the third largest city in the entire Roman empire. How do you think the apostles felt when they saw that the Gospel was taking root there (v. 23)?

What do you feel God may be asking you to do that you find difficult? Why would it be worth the cost of what it might take? What steps can you take to be a part of God's plans this week? Who can you invite to come alongside you?

Why do you think the first people to go out shared the Gospel only with the Jews? What do you think compelled those from Cypress and Cyrene to share with Gentiles (v. 19-20)?

When was a time you have had to step out of your comfort zone and take part in something challenging to you?

God's hand was with those who shared with the Gentiles. What does this tell us about who we should be sharing the Gospel with? What people does God desire to see come into His Kingdom?

How has this study helped you to see Jesus more clearly?
