What does God say is true of someone who is in Christ? What are we commanded to do in these verses?

Read Colossians 3:5-9.

What are the commands in these verses?

If you feel comfortable sharing, what specific sins marked your life before you came to know Christ?

As a follower of Jesus, what sins do you still struggle to put to death?

What is the difference between committing sin and walking in/living in sin?

Read Colossians 3:9-11.

How has God renewed His image in you since you came to know Christ? In what ways has your sin had an impact on others in your life?

How does verse 11 provide context for applying this passage?

What specific things have you done to put to death or put off specific areas of sin in your life? What are some boundaries you have established? Who holds you accountable?

Close your time by writing a prayer request on an index card. Men trade cards with other men in the group, women with other women. Now commit to praying for that person's request every day this week.
