Connect in Conversation

Read Matthew 2

- What does it mean that Jesus is King?
- Discuss as a family the different ways we can worship Jesus.
- Why do you think the Wise Men rejoiced exceedingly with great joy?
 - (Think about the Old Testament and what God's people had been waiting for)
- If you had to travel across the country and avoid an evil ruler, who would be the people you would travel with?

Memory Verse

Matthew 1:21 NLT

“And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.”

Prayer

Praise: What is something you love about Who God Is?

Thanksgiving: What is something you are thankful for this week?

Pray for Others: Are there others that need prayer?

Confession: Is there anything in your heart that needs cleaning out?

Requests: What needs prayer?

Creating Space

Be intentional this week about different ways of worship. Could you pick something intentional to do each day after dinner or at dinner? (prayer, fasting, singing songs, reading scripture, going on a nature walk)

Discuss why God deserves our worship? Have the kids process this question throughout the week and when you circle back up to worship together discuss some answers. Have them keep an eye out for anything in our world that might deserve the same type of worship (aka there is nothing, but sometimes it takes the intentional recognition of this to create an AH HA moment).
