

Rescue and Wandering

Big Idea: Remember what God has done and trust Him to provide. How do we trust God in all times?

Table Talk:

Read Numbers 13

When you look at a tough situation do you see it from a lens of fear (giant people) or confidence (giant fruit) in God?

What situations are you looking at now? How can you trust that God is bigger?

What reasons did the Israelites have to trust God?

Read Numbers 14:1-12; 34-35

The Israelites rebel against the Lord in their fear. What is fear holding you back from accomplishing what the Lord has for you?

What was the punishment for the Israelites lack of trust?

Activity Walk:

Create different fruits (pictures below) hang the fruits in your children's bedrooms as a reminder to not be afraid and trust God with any situation. Older kids can write verses across their piece of fruit to add truth.







• **Thanksgiving:** Fill out the Thanksgiving Sheet together sent home from church OR spend some time as a family remembering what God has done by sharing what you are thankful for. Then pray that your family would trust God to provide in the coming year.
