1 TIMOTHY I Preserve Sound Doctrine

September 12, 2021

1 Timothy 1:1-11

We have all been fooled at some point in our lives. Share an example of a time you believed something that turned out to be untrue. What was it that made you believe the lie?

What does the passage teach us about the relationship between Paul and Timothy? What can we learn about our spiritual relationships from them?

In the opening portion of this letter, what was the challenge that Paul issued to the young pastor named Timothy? Why is this important to the church?

What are the outcomes or results of teaching false doctrine or speculation? Have you ever observed this in real life?

How would you classify something as orthodox (sound doctrine) or heresy (false doctrine)?

What is the proper role of God's law? Who is it made for? How can it help them?

Close your time together praying for your group's study of 1 Timothy. Ask the Lord to help you discern truth from error. Pray James 1:5 and 1 Corinthians 2:13 for your group.
