HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: Equipped with Everything Good to Do His Will

Hebrews 13:1-21

A Study of Hebrews is a devotional book produced by Fellowship to aid in understanding the book of Hebrews. The questions in the weekly discussion guide can be found in this book, along with daily readings, devotionals, and other inspirational material.

How does it feel to be in the final chapter of this book? Do you have a sense of accomplishment? Share with the group your emotions about wrapping up this study.

Read Hebrews 13:1-21.

There are many commands in this passage. Underline them. Which ones seem difficult? Which ones do you feel convicted about? Share with the group.

Underline each of the verbs in verses 15-18. Circle all the ways God is described in verse 20. Which of these descriptions jumps out at you and why? Why is it significant that Jesus is unchanging?

Do any of the commands stand out to you and convict you of something you are or are not doing in your life? Why are you engaging or not engaging in that practice rather than following Jesus in obedience?

How do you identify with Jesus in His rejection? How do you identify with the suffering of those who have suffered on His behalf? How do you think they would view your life and commitment to Jesus? Why?

What do you think is the most important command in this final section? Why?

We are told the most pleasing sacrifice we bring to God is the praise of His name through a life that does good and shares what we have. How often do you find yourself giving praise to God and offering your time and resources to others? How can you do this more?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week? Share how this study of Hebrews has affected your walk with the Lord. What will you remember from this study?

Thank God for the book of Hebrews, recalling specific things He has taught you. Praise His name and adore Him for who He is. Pray for your church leadership, that they would have wisdom, pursue truth, run from sin, and be guided by the Holy Spirit in all things.
