Read Numbers 11:4-32. What were the circumstance in Numbers 11 that caused Moses and the Lord to have a conversation? How did the Lord plan to address the concerns of His people?

How did Moses react to the Lord's promise of providing meat for the nation of Israel? After doubting the Lord's ability to deliver on His promise of meat, what was the Lord's question to Moses? (See [Numbers 11:23](#).)

What reasons can you think of that Moses should have had confidence in the Lord? Why do you think Moses would have doubted the Lord?

How was God's question to Moses answered? Did the people get what they asked for?

What about you? When have you doubted the Lord's ability to deliver on a promise or to accomplish His will? What have you stopped praying for because you have not received an answer yet? Who have you given up on because life-change has not happened yet? Is there a circumstance that feels too big for even God to turn around?

How can today's passage reignite your faith in God's power and might?
