

The animals

 "I have no need of a bull from your stall or of goats from your pens, for every animal of the forest is mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills. I know every bird in the mountains, and the insects in the fields are mine."
 (Psalm 50:9-11)

Therefore...

- Therefore every <u>spending/financial</u> decision is a <u>spiritual</u> one.
- It will also influence how we <u>care</u> for our/God's possessions.
- This demands a <u>major shift</u> in our thinking when we begin to see our <u>material possessions</u> as God sees them.

Steps to changing our thinking:

- Meditate on 1 Chronicles 29:11-12.
- Be aware of the Lord's <u>ownership</u> of all you have.
- Be careful in the use of <u>my, mine, ours</u> in referring to material wealth you possess
- Begin to consider <u>God's choices</u> for His things in your possession
