



THE BEGINNINGS

Big Idea: Man sins, destroying the perfect world.
What is the consequence of sin?

Table Talk:

Read Genesis 3:1-24

What happened to our perfect world?

Who tempted Eve to eat the apple? Who tempts us to make sinful decisions?

Did the fruit look good? Does sin seem good at first too?

What can we do to protect us from temptation?

How do you think God feels when we choose sin over him?

What are the consequences of sin?

Activity Walk :

- Pray as a family and ask for forgiveness from any sin that may be hindering your walk with God.
- Draw two trees on a white sheet of paper. Spend some time writing different sins in one tree and fruit of the spirit in the other tree. Discuss the differences of the two trees and what they produce... eg. *Kindness shows the love of Jesus to others, whereas mean words can make someone feel really sad.*
