1 John 4:9-10 NLT

God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. (K-2) This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. (3-5)

Creating Space

Gather as a family. Take a piece of paper and crinkle it into a ball. Unfold the paper and ask the kids to make the wrinkles go away. They have to make the paper completely flat again. Give them a few minutes to try.

You can't. Sin forever places a stain in our lives. There are consequences and effects of sin that we can never fully recover from. However, Jesus (place a plain white paper in front of the folded one) stands in your place in from of God. God only sees our perfect white paper because the blood of Jesus covers the wrinkles left behind. He gives us freedom from our sins.
