HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: Melchizedek

June 6, 2021

[Hebrews 5:1-10; 7:1-22](#)

A Study of Hebrews is a devotional book produced by Fellowship to aid in understanding the book of Hebrews. The questions in the weekly discussion guide can be found in this book, along with daily readings, devotionals, and other inspirational material.

What is something you learned the hard way? What did you learn from the difficult experience? Do you think you could have learned it any other way?

Read [Genesis 14:17-20](#) and [Psalm 110:1-7](#).

How do these Old Testament passages fit together? Who is Melchizedek? (Review commentaries, a study Bible, and refer to page 138 in the *Study of Hebrews* book.)

With that context in mind, read [Hebrews 5:1-10](#) and [7:1-22](#).

What is the function of a priest? How did Christ become qualified to represent us before God?

How can you offer prayers to God like Jesus did?

What has changed about the priesthood according to [Hebrews 7:11-14](#)? Why was this change necessary? Why could perfection never be attained through the old priesthood?

The author returns to Psalm 110 in [Hebrews 7:21](#). What is God swearing in this verse? How does this give us a better hope? What is the significance of the better covenant we have in Christ ([Hebrews 7:22](#), [Jeremiah 31:31-34](#))?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week? Close your time together in prayer. Pray specifically for people by name who do not know Jesus to come to know Him.
