90 Days of Prayer Guide

Adoration:

- You are *Elohim*, sovereign and transcendent over all the earth (Deuteronomy 3:22).
- As *El-Shaddai*, you are God Almighty, powerful and strong (Genesis 17:1).
- As *Yahweh Jireh*, you are “The Lord Will Provide” (Genesis 22:14).

Confession:

- “Therefore, confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.” James 5:16
- “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.” I John 1:9-10
- Prayerfully confess individual sins of mind, heart, tongue, and behavior

Thanksgiving:

- We give thanks for:
 - 40 years of ministry at Fellowship
 - The Spirit’s wisdom and guidance
 - God’s continuous protection over and provision for His people
- “Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.” 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Supplication:

- For family
 - Unity and love in individual families that reach out in hospitality towards others (Romans 12:9-13)
 - Re-establishment of relationships between parents and children
 - To be a light in their neighborhood and schools (Matthew 5:14-16)
- For neighbors
 - For guidance in truth and hope in God (Psalms 25:4-5)
 - To know and follow Christ wholeheartedly (John 17:3)
 - “Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.” (Colossians 4:2-6)
- For workplace
 - Integrity among Christian workers (Acts 24:6)
 - Christian workers to display Christ-like humility and service to their co-workers (Philippians 2:3)
 - “Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” (Colossians 3:23-24)

- For Fellowship small groups
 - Integrity – that our people reflect kingdom values rather than the world’s values (1 Peter 2:11, 1 Corinthians 13:6)
 - That our people would experience a holy fear of the Lord
 - Unity with one another and the church that reveals God’s love to the world (John 17:23)

- Fellowship Fayetteville
 - For discipleship of new leaders (Ephesians 4:11-12)
 - Unity with and among churches that reveal God’s love to the world (John 17:23)
 - Elders to be led with clarity and wisdom and to be given discernment regarding decisions for expansion (Acts 20:28)

- Local Schools
 - Wisdom for teachers and administrators as they shepherd children
 - That our FSM students would be a humble and bold gospel light

- Government
 - Pray for leaders at the local, state, and federal levels, that God would grant them wisdom to act with integrity (Romans 13:1-2)

- Community Partners
 - Pray for parachurch ministries and local organizations, for courage and dependence on God (Psalm 91) and unity with other churches (John 17:23)

- University of Arkansas/JBU
 - Pray for a desire for truth (Psalm 1:1-2)
 - Pray for revival (James 4:8)

- Churches in our Community
 - To find new zeal and commitment to the mission and purpose of Jesus Christ (Matthew 22:37)
 - Unity with and among churches that reveal God’s love to the world (John 17:23)
 - That God’s people would experience a holy fear of the Lord

- Nation
 - That Americans encounter the true God who rules over the country (Amos 4:13)
 - That our nation would humbly and diligently seek Him (1 Timothy 2:1-4)

- Global
 - That the unsaved would be drawn to a saving encounter with Christ (Eph. 1:17-23)
 - That the Lord would raise up global workers willing to forsake comforts for the cause of Christ (Luke 6:38)
