And in the talking and teaching that Jesus did, He revealed some very frank and direct thoughts that God has about what He chooses to entrust to us:

No one can serve two masters...you cannot serve both God and money! Mark 6:24 NIV

Do not store up for yourselves on earth...²⁰But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven. Matthew 6:19-20 NIV

For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Mark 6:21 NIV

But alongside those exhortations/warnings, He also says:

...how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him! Mark 7:11 NIV

And the Apostle Paul adds:

...God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. 1 Timothy 6:17NIV

How do we live in a way that aligns with and reflects God's heart in this tension of owning things but not letting them own us? What guidance does the Bible give? And how does that work out in very practical ways?
