Thank You For Taking Care of Our Needs God Sends Special Food – Preschooler’s Bible 105 - 107

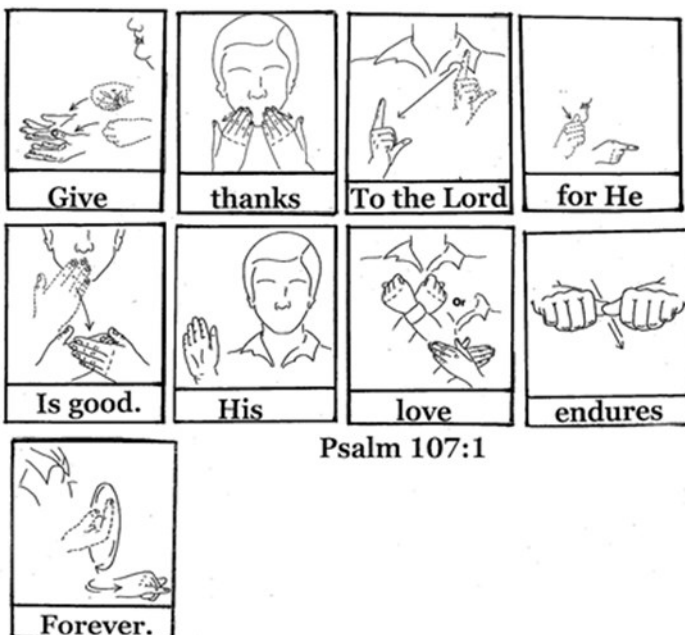
Reference: Exodus 16

Moses and his people are in a desert. There are no stores in the desert. There are no gardens or fields. There are no vineyards. There is no food at all. “We’re hungry,” the people say. You can see why they are hungry, can’t you? “God will send good food for you,” Moses tells his people. But how can He? How can God give them food? There is no food to give. But God does send good food. Each day He sends special bread. It is called manna. God does not need stores. He does not need gardens. God sends manna as a special gift. God can do anything, can’t He? Now the people have all they can eat. The manna is wonderful food. It tastes good. There is plenty of it. “Thank you, God,” Moses often prays. “Thank you, God,” the people also pray.
