What was the primary way you were disciplined growing up? Would you discipline your children the same way? Is discipline in school different now than when you were in school? What do you think is the purpose of discipline at home or in school?

Read [Hebrews 12:3-11](#).

Underline any instance where the author encourages the reader to do something.

Circle each version of the word “discipline.”

Discipline is used both as a noun and a verb in the passage. What is the difference? How does that affect how we read the passage?

How does seeing the way Jesus dealt with trials, pain, and difficulty lead you in how you respond to hardship?

How has discipline or a trial shaped you? What did you learn? How are you encouraged by what you learned?

If you are in the middle of a trial, what helps you cling to God’s promises?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week?

Close your time together in prayer. Thank God that He has brought you through the trials you have suffered. Name some of those specific trials. Thank Him for the specific things He has taught you and how He has grown your character. Ask Him to keep revealing Himself to you. Thank Him for protecting you from unseen and unknown difficulties. Praise Him for sending His only Son to earth for your sake.
