HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: Draw Near to God and Find Rest | [Hebrews 4:11-16](#)

A Study of Hebrews is a devotional book produced by Fellowship to aid in understanding the book of Hebrews. The questions in the weekly discussion guide can be found in this book, along with daily readings, devotionals, and other inspirational material.

Are you naturally empathic or is it hard for you to put yourself in the place of another? What emotion do you feel when you see someone crying? Is your tendency to enter into someone else's pain or do you tend to remain aloof when someone is hurting?

Read [Hebrews 4:11-16](#).

Underline and write down descriptions of God's Word and what it does in your life. Share how you have seen God's Word at work in your own life.

Write down character traits of God you see in this passage. Share with the group.

Circle every command or every time the author says, "let us." What is the writer of Hebrews asking his audience to do?

What has been your experience with approaching the throne of God? How would you feel standing before Him right now? Why?

How does it make you feel that every time you approach God's throne, He is eager to show you mercy? How does this make you feel about confessing sin?

What are some areas where you need to approach God and ask Him for mercy?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week?

As you prepare to close your time together in prayer, look at what you observed about God in the passage and praise Him for these things. Thank Him for revealing these things to you through His Word. Spend some time praying silently. Picture yourself before His throne (physically get on your knees if you are able) and silently confess anything that comes to your mind for which you need to ask forgiveness. Ask for forgiveness in confidence knowing He knows all you have done or thought and wants to grant you mercy and grace! End your time by praising God aloud for one aspect of His character that you are thankful for.
