1 Timothy 6:3-10, 17-19

Is having money or using money wrong? Why is the “love of” money a root of all kinds of evil?

What are the instructions for the rich in verses 17-19? Why are these critical to understand?

What one or two steps can you take to avoid the trap of greed (“love of money”) in your life?

In what ways can you practice godly contentment as an individual, couple, or family?
