Read Genesis 1 & 2 or the story of creation in any children's Bible.

- What was the creation that God loved the most?
- What do you love about the way God created you? (Spend time sharing personal, but also encouraging each other)
- What do you feel when you here God is the creator of all things?

 **Memory Verse**

**1 John 4:9-10 NLT**

God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. (K-2) This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. (3-5)

 **Prayer**

Praise: What is something you love about Who God Is?

Thanksgiving: What is something you are thankful for this week?

Pray for Others: Are there others that need prayer?

Confession: Is there anything in your heart that needs cleaning out?

Requests: What needs prayer?

 **Creating Space**

Make a nature journal. You can create one from a few white pages folded with the staple down the middle, buy a cheap journal from Walmart, etc. Spend time this week in nature. Go on walks, hikes, etc... Have your kids observe and take notes of the details of creation. Have them draw the nature they see, research or look up information about the creation.

Spend time as a family together sharing what you have learned. How do these details and these findings reveal more about our Creator God??
