### the Helper in you

As a mom to three kids, I count on some weekend time to recharge and do a few things for myself. I woke up early on a glorious rare Saturday with nothing on our schedule. I walked through my home and noticed it advertising needs through floating pet hair, laundry that resembled piles of fall leaves and floors that needed mopping. I was feeling tired and unmotivated to do anything productive for others or myself. My thoughts were already justifying the decision to check out of the day saying I deserve a closed curtain, do nothing,



Netflix and cereal kind of day. There is always tomorrow and one day off won't hurt anything.

Then a text came through on my phone. A friend was encouraging me with her thoughts of being intentional with our spiritual and physical health.

I thought about her words and was able to receive a greater understanding. I was allowing myself to be tricked and deceived into wasting the gift of a day. I let my focus drift. But God always has a plan and sent a helper to me that morning when I didn't even think I needed one. That one thoughtful and encouraging text sent me to my Bible when I was resolute to skip it all.

I spent intentional time with the Lord. I read my Bible, a daily devotional, and prayed for His direction and influence over my day. Afterwards I walked through my house with new thoughts and recognized I felt differently about my plans to quit for the day and saw new opportunities instead. I focused on what good I could do for those around me. I was reminded in order to grow spiritually that I am to take in the Word. My time with the Lord renewed my outlook for the day and I wanted to reflect Jesus to others. Lean into those friends that encourage you and call you to be more.



#### **Personal Bible Study 1: How to study the Bible** A Fellowship Core Training Series


