What is the most meaningful part of the Christmas season for you?

How does this shape your understanding of God's ultimate plan to send a Savior for all of mankind and to establish His Kingdom forever? In what ways is Jesus the good, true, and perfect King?

**Grow**

**Read 2 Samuel 7:12-13.** What is the promise that the Lord God made to King David in these verses? What was the near-term prophecy and what was the long-term prophecy regarding his kingdom?

How do you see Jesus establishing His kingdom today? Is He the King of your life? How are you able to take part in His kingdom and live under His perfect rule?

**Read 1 Kings 2:1-4.** As the near-term prophecy was fulfilled, what was King David's final advice as he passed his throne to his son, Solomon?

**Read Isaiah 9:6-7.** How does the prophet Isaiah expound on the long-term prophecy from [2 Samuel 7:13](#)? How does he describe this son who is to come? In what ways do you see this passage connecting to Jesus of the New Testament?

**Read Luke 2:26-33.** What was the message sent to Mary—almost 1,000 years after God's promise to King David and 700 years after the prophecy recorded in Isaiah? How does this passage show the fulfillment of God's promise and prophecy from the Old Testament writings listed above?
