Next week, we begin our study of 1 Thessalonians. Take some time to do a first read of the entire book (should take you about 15-20 minutes). 1 Thessalonians was a letter written by the Apostle Paul in the 1st Century A.D. and as with most of the New Testament letters, it was meant to be read out loud among the followers of Jesus who had come together to celebrate and remember the risen Messiah.

So, throughout this series we want to plug into that historical Christian tradition of reading the Scriptures aloud together in community.
