**Read Colossians 3:14-17.**

What does it look like for you to love others in the midst of conflict? When you encounter seasons of hardship, how do you connect with others?

Who are the people you are vulnerable with and have permission to speak into your life? How have those people challenged you to grow in your walk with Jesus?

To “let the word of Christ dwell in you richly” can be understood as letting it “have ample room” in your heart to do the work it intends to do. What things in your heart prevent you from doing that?

What things are you holding onto that keep you from doing all things “whether in word or deed...in the name of the Lord Jesus”? What can it look like for you to start surrendering those things to Christ?

What has the Lord revealed to you in this four-week series? What are next steps for you to continue your journey toward freedom in Christ?
