1 TIMOTHY | Dealing with Apostasy

1 Timothy 3:14-4:5

Are you the kind of person who prefers to read the instruction manual for a new purchase? Why or why not?

Why did Paul write this letter to Timothy? What was the central focus of his instruction?

The passage forecasts that some people will abandon the faith. According to the passage, what are some reasons people will leave the faith? In your experience, what causes people to abandon the faith?

What is the difference between someone who rejects the faith or denies the Lord and someone who falls into temptation for a time?

Have you experienced someone teaching that certain foods or experiences are “forbidden” even though the Scriptures do not teach that standard?

How can prayer, the Word, and consecration guide us in whether to partake or not partake in certain foods or experiences?

Spend time praying together. Thank our Lord for everything good He has created (verse 4). Seek His wisdom in handling situations like those mentioned in this passage which can divide believers, families, and even churches.
