Big Idea: Abraham was a man of FAITH, that trusted God was a promise keeper. How did Abraham trust God?

Table Talk:

Read Genesis 15:1-21

What did God promise to Abraham? Could Abraham see these promises? Had any of them come true yet? Is it hard to trust God sometimes in promises we cannot see? God made a covenant, or agreement, with Abraham. He was going to deliver on his promise, but God's people were not going to make it easy.

Activity Walk:

- Discuss around the table one night what other things in our world need "covenants" or agreements? Write one as a family... what can you all agree to over the next month?
- Find the song "Father Abraham" enjoy dancing with your family to this silly song.
- Take a night and bundle and see the stars. Think about everyone you know is a believer. We are all a part of God's family, and this same sky is what Abraham and God looked at together the night of their agreement. God's promises came true.
- Make a poster of all of God's promises. How have you already seen him deliver on those promises?
