### *BELONG*

Growing up, what was the best thing about your hometown? Would the people you grew up with be surprised at who you are or what you are doing now? Why or why not?

What are the biggest internal obstacles that hinder you from applying Scripture to your daily life? How might you overcome those? Where can you get help to overcome those obstacles?

### *GROW*

**Read Luke 4:16-22.**

In [Luke 4:18-19](#) Jesus reads from [Isaiah 61:1-2](#). What are the five things the prophet says the Spirit will anoint the Messiah to do? How will Jesus accomplish those five things?

What are you learning about in your life right now? How does this passage help you see Jesus more clearly?

What is the response of the people in [v. 22](#)? Why do you think they respond this way?

**Read Luke 4:23-30.**

Does the response of Jesus in [vv. 23-27](#) surprise you? Why do you think He said these things? Based on their reaction in [vv. 28-29](#), what did the people think Jesus was saying?

Do you find it hard to personally accept all parts of Jesus' teaching? Why? What are some examples?

How does seeing the fullness of your sin cause you to have a greater view of God's grace?
