

Who is someone in your life that is older and has inspired you by living a life of faithfulness to God?

Read Joshua 13:1-7. What is God's challenge for Joshua in verse 1? What promise does God make about the task in verse 6?

What "unfinished business" do you sense the Lord may want you to tackle in the coming year? What "obstacles" tend to keep us from completing what God has given us to do? In what ways have you seen Him already at work, clearing the way for you?

Read Joshua 14:6-14. What do you remember about Caleb from the time that Moses sent him out with eleven others to spy in the promised land?

Going Deeper: To learn more of the backstory about Caleb and Joshua, refer to **Numbers 13:1-16, 26-30** and **Numbers 14:5-9, 26-34**. How are Caleb and Joshua inspiring for Christians today?

What does **Joshua 14:6-14** tell us about Caleb's character? What do you think it was like for Caleb and Joshua to speak up and live differently from all of the other people of their time? What do you believe drove them to do so?

What do we learn in **Joshua 13-14** about God? What can we take away from the lives of Joshua and Caleb? How can they encourage or challenge us today? Who has been a "Caleb" in your life that has waited on and trusted the Lord greatly throughout life?
