The Woods in Winter



It is a peaceful morning in my woods. The only sounds are the different birds at the feeders and the dew dripping in the eaves. There is patchy fog in the treetops that seems to muffle sounds...even as it amplifies them. I could stay out here all day, wrapped in a quilt, with my coffee and my Lord. I love the woods in winter. This is Elohim's rest-time for His creation — and for me. The gardens and beds have been put to sleep and the holidays are packed up for another year.

As I look out back towards the woods, I can see all the bare branches swaying in the wind and I know the promise of new life is just below the surface – awaiting spring. But, for now, there is a time of rest and reflection.

Winter in the woods allows me to see things that are hidden in the other seasons by the beauty around me. I can see far back into the woods that are now open and transparent. There is a special beauty in the intricate framework of the bare limbs and branches. Each variety is different in its growth pattern. Some are tall and straight as they reach for the life-giving sunshine, while others are twisted and curving, sometimes even growing down toward the ground before once again turning toward the light. Often, I can see a reason for the twist and turn. Sometimes it is another tree in the way – or an injury to a limb. Other times the reason is not apparent. All this is hidden when there are leaves on the trees! Only in the winter do the forces that shape the tree's structure become evident. Winter in the woods lets me see much that has been hidden.

When I look at the bare trees, I realize they are a picture of our lives. Some have lived a very straight, upright life before Him. I have friends who have traveled before Him all their lives and sought His Light. Their branches are beautiful and upright – to be admired and emulated. Others are formed and molded by adverse circumstances beyond their control, and they must continually twist and fight to seek His life-giving Light. God creates a very special beauty in their twisted limbs. Many of us find ourselves at times heading away from His will only to turn back and search for His Light again and again.

As I grow older, into the winter of my life, I can more readily appreciate what is underneath. As my 'leaves' fall away I know I am not a perfect specimen! My life has not always been spent seeking 'outward' and 'upward'. My focus has not always been on my Lord and on others. I have many branches that have turned 'inward' – toward my own selfish interests. Sometimes, they have also turned 'down' seeking darkness and away from the Light. In this 'winter' of my life, my desire is to be more open and transparent to those around me.... for my growth to be out and up toward His Light.

God's people are like His trees. When we are viewed in the summer of our lives, we make a

beautiful picture of His Love. It takes the winter to show how He has formed each of us in different ways, and how He uses all of us to create the unity of His Church.

I pray for each of you to know and understand that God is creating beauty in your life as you are shaped by His hand in every circumstance.

Thank You, Abba, for the blessings you shower upon me and the understanding You give me as I watch Your beautiful Creation. I long for the day when I will see clearly what now is only a shadow. (1Corinthians 13:12)



Personal Bible Study 1: How to study the Bible A Fellowship Core Training Series


