1 TIMOTHY I Instructions on Worship: The Priority of Prayer

September 26, 2021

1 Timothy 2:1-8

Who is the most famous person you have ever met? What was it like to meet them? Have you ever met a political leader? How do you feel about praying for leaders you have never met?

In Paul's call to prayer, what is the tone of the request? Who should we pray for? Who specifically is mentioned and why is this important?

What is the effect of prayer on our heart?

How does God feel about prayer? Why do you think this is true?

Verses 4-6 describe both the breadth of God's love and the narrow pathway to salvation. How can God be both inclusive and exclusive all at the same time?

Paul, who was a follower of Christ with a Hebrew background, lived in a secular Roman world. What was the goal of his prayer and ministry? Why is this significant?

How can your group be praying for you? Spend some time as a group praying for our leaders, for people everywhere to come to know Jesus, and for the specific prayer needs within the group.
