COME TOGETHER | We Worship Together

Revelation 7:9-12; Romans 12:1-2

What was worship like in the church you attended as a child? What did you like about it?

Read Revelation 7:9-12. These verses describe a prophetic vision of a future time in which believers in Jesus will gather in heavenly worship.

What observations can you make about Christian worship from the passage? Describe the scene, including who will be present, how they will worship, who they will worship and why, etc.

Why do you think God has placed this “sneak preview” in Scripture for us today? How does—or how should—this passage impact the way we respond to God in worship?

Read Romans 12:1-2. List ways this passage connects personal, spiritual worship to how we live.

What is the connection between living sacrifices and personal worship?

What does it mean for us to live “holy and acceptable to God”? How does verse 2 of this passage help clarify and encourage us to live this way?

Based on these passages, what have you learned about worship that you can put into practice in the coming week?
