- Celebrate Isaac’s marriage to Rebekah and eat cake together!

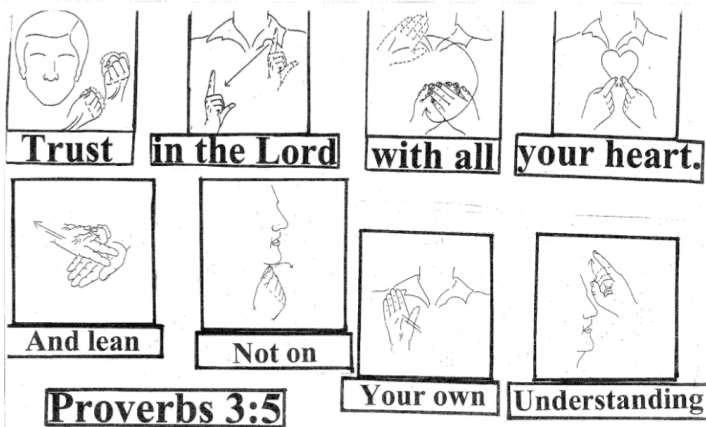
Bible Story

Isaac is Born: The Preschooler's Bible -- Pages 36-39

Reference: Genesis 18 & 21
