How do you respond when Jesus desires to give “good news” to people who are different—perhaps, even offensive to us in some way or those we are tempted to treat as enemies?

What would it look like for you to “know and express the authentic Christ” this week according to this passage? How might that be worth the discomfort of growth or risk of rejection?
