

- Amplified Version (Jn 14:1-6)

"Do not let your heart be troubled (afraid, cowardly). Believe [confidently] in God and trust in Him, [have faith, hold on to it, rely on it, keep going and] believe also in Me. <sup>2</sup> In My Father's house are many dwelling places. If it were not so, I would have told you, because I am going there to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and I will take you to Myself, so that where I am you may be also. <sup>4</sup> And [to the place] where I am going, you know the way." <sup>5</sup> Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going; so how can we know the way?" <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, "I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
