HEBREWS | Jesus is Greater: History of Faith

Hebrews 11:1-40

A Study of Hebrews is a devotional book produced by Fellowship to aid in understanding the book of Hebrews. The questions in the weekly discussion guide can be found in this book, along with daily readings, devotionals, and other inspirational material.

What is a hall of fame you would like to visit? Maybe it's one of the sports halls, the Hollywood Walk of Fame, or something like the Civil Rights Museum. What is it about the people that are honored there that makes you want to visit?

Read Hebrews 11:1-40.

Circle all the names listed as heroes of faith in Hebrews 11. Which ones stand out to you? Why?

Underline the commands or promises of God. Were those promises just for those people or do they continue across time?

Mark the challenges, trials, difficulties, and circumstances the various "heroes" faced throughout their lives. Which of these challenges can you relate to? Share with the group.

Which hero of faith mentioned do you most identify with right now? Who do you look at and say, "I've been where they are" or "I want to have that kind of faith"?

What do you currently place your faith in that seems more secure than God? How have you falsely placed your security in tangible assets, people, or gifts in this life instead of God? Identify them and then confess them to God.

How can you grow to be more confident of who God is, knowing more fully that the object of your faith is reliable?

What does this passage tell us that Jesus is greater than? How will knowing that Jesus is greater affect how you live this week? Close your time together in prayer. Pray that God would help you place your faith and security in God alone. Pray for clarity to see Him at work in your life and the world around you. Confess any doubts you have (God is not afraid of your doubts). Pray that He would be close to you and that you would seek and know His presence.
