

How to Use The Weekly Worship Guides

We want to equip you to disciple your families well during this season. This guide can serve as a way to engage your family in interactive worship centered around God's Word and in prayer. You could also gather a couple of neighbors in your front yard and worship together!

- **Pray:** Ask the Holy Spirit to help everyone hear God's voice and worship Him.
- **Prepare:** Get everything you need before the service starts (printed worship guides, Bibles, a way to sing, etc.)
- **Gather:** Bring your family together for a time of worship. You could also invite others in your neighborhood to worship in your front yard.
- **Involve:** Include everyone in the worship time. Divide out the parts to family members or neighbors. Have a child lead the Call to Worship or prayer or have a neighbor read one of the Scriptures.
- **Participate:** Model worship for your family by singing, praying, and opening God's Word. Remind everyone that church is God's family - a group of people committed together to love and follow Jesus - not a building.

Call to Worship

Have someone read the unbolded words and everyone respond by reading the bolded parts together.

Call to Worship (Psalm 92:1-5; 12:15)

It is good to praise the Lord and make music to your name, O Most High, **proclaiming your love in the morning and your faithfulness at night**, to the music of the ten-stringed lyre and the melody of the harp. **For you make me glad by your deeds, Lord; I sing for joy at what your hands have done.** How great are your works, Lord, how profound your thoughts!

The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; **planted in the house of the Lord, they will flourish in the courts of our God.** They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green, **proclaiming, "The Lord is upright; he is my Rock, and there is no wickedness in him."**

Father, You have had a plan since the beginning of time to redeem the world You have created! You are loving and sovereign over this world. Thank You for bearing my sin and shame on the cross. Thank You for taking my punishment. I am sorry when I fail to remember what You accomplished for me.
